Following on from our previous update in January, please find the latest update on progress with the Burncrooks water improvement project.

Environment

Application for the Controlled Activities Regulation (CAR) licence was submitted to SEPA in December.

Ground Investigations

Ground investigation to confirm the design and final pipe route is almost complete.

Trial holes at the Allander water were completed in Jan 2019. Further trial holes will be carried out in Mugdock Country Park w/c 11th Feb around. Signage will be in place in advance of the start of these works.

We are currently liaising with East Dunbartonshire Council, Scottish National Heritage and Mugdock Country park re tree/hedge removal along the pipeline route. It is likely that this work will commence mid-February, in advance of the bird nesting season. The initial de-vegetation will take place within private land followed by tree and shrub clearance within the SSSI in Mugdock Country Park, Allander Water, Craigton and Craigdhu burns.

The pipeline route has been marked out using small wooden marker posts.

Project Timescales

Preliminary site set up has been established at Bankell. Planned start on site will commence once the survey and design work has been completed. This will be around spring 2019.

We will continue to provide regular updates to the local community and stakeholders as we work towards delivering this important project, which will improve services to more than 54,000 customers.
