Following on from our previous update in March, please find the latest update on progress with the Burncrooks water improvement project.

Environment

Application for the Controlled Activities Regulation (CAR) licence was submitted to SEPA in December. We are stilling awaiting the final copy from SEPA.

Investigations

Ground investigation to confirm the design and final pipe route is now complete.

Tree and hedge removed commenced on private land early March this work is almost complete.

Sections of the pipeline route have been marked out using small wooden marker posts.

Project Timescales

Site set up has been established at Bankell with additional site cabins being delivered in the last week. Start on site, which will be earth moving activities at Bankell, is scheduled to start w/c mon 6^{th} May.

Our second site compound, due to be set up in the coming weeks will be located within the SW owned field which is north of Drumclog car park. A 5 day lane closure is scheduled to start on Monday 6th May to facilitate this.

An information event is planned for Wednesday 8th May from 3pm until 6pm in Milngavie Town Hall. Please come along and find out what is planned for the project in the next 3 to 6 months. This will include road traffic management, construction programme and impact on Drumclog car park.
