What we are doing

We are replacing a short storm outfall with a new screened, longer outfall, helping to improve water quality in the bay and the environment of the Firth of Clyde. Further to the letter issued in 15th April 2019, we write to inform you of the next stages.

When are we doing it

We have completed the installation of the extended outfall pipe. The closed-off section of beach will be back open by 12th June.

Work on Warrenpark Road will continue for approximately three months. Traffic lights will be required at the bottom of Anthony Road for the next six weeks.

What happens next

Your water supply should not be affected during this period and toilets and sinks can be used as normal.

- We are increasing the sewer capacity beneath Warrenpark Road and building a new chamber for the outfall screen. This means the focus of work over the next stage will be on Warrenpark Road, with an increase in machinery and excavation work. Warrenpark Road will remain closed for approximately three months. There will be an increase in noise during some parts of these works.
- Anthony Road will remain open for the rest of the project, except towards the end of the project a short period for permanent road surfacing.
- We anticipate completion, including reinstatement of all areas, in September.
