



## Taking care of your waste water network

## Why are we doing this?

- The existing process equipment has served well but is now nearing end of serviceable life creating increased equipment failures. This obviously needs additional operator and maintenance interventions to maintain the treatment process operation. Due to the age of the plant and equipment, replacement parts and spares are no longer manufactured.
- The process requires to be refurbished, replaced and upgraded with modern equipment to ensure the integrity of this key Scottish Water asset is maintained and protected.

## What does this involve?

- The improvements being made here include a new, modern treatment process and replacing some of the existing required facilities on the treatment works, new for old.
- The upgrades also include necessary changes that are required for the health and safety of the operations personnel and any visitors to the site.
- A new access entrance and roadway will be constructed within the treatment works to permit access for maintenance of the new plant.
- There will also be some vegetation and tree removal to the north-east of the site with replanting included in the construction project works.
- Ultimately, these works will help improve our ability to continue to provide an improved stability of the waste water treatment process and the resilience of the local waste water network.
- The planned improvements will ensure Scottish Water compliance with requirements of the environmental regulations and that customers continue to enjoy great Scottish Water service.
