WHAT is happening?

Scottish Water Services Grampian is planning to clean out and inspect a number of process units within in the sludge treatment centre. Work by specialist contractors will commence on the 11th January. During this work there is a potential for an increase in localised odour within the sludge building as it will be necessary to open vessels to carry out this work. An odour risk assessment has been undertaken by the operations team and shared with Regulators. This sets out the activity plans for use of temporary equipment and measures for minimising odour risks. Any localised odour from within the treatment building will be vented through the odour control system for treatment and not directly to atmosphere.

WHY are we telling you?

Through work with the community and the WwTW Liaison Group in recent years, we remain committed to ensuring that you are advised of operational changes or odour risks.

WHEN is this happening?

This notification relates to the 11th January to 18th January 2019, when the sludge vessels will be opened for cleaning. Further updates will be issued as required.
