WHAT is happening?		

Scottish Water Services Grampian is planning to replace the carbon media in the odour control unit for the sludge treatment centre at Nigg. The current media needs to be replaced to ensure continuous effective treatment of potentially odorous gases generated within the sludge treatment centre. This work is being completed during the shutdown of some of the processes within the sludge treatment centre to minimise the odour risk to the community. There is a potential for an increase in localised odour from within the sludge building as it will be necessary to shut down the odour control system to complete this work. An odour risk assessment has been undertaken by the operations team and shared with Regulators. This sets out the activity plans and measures for minimising odour risks.

# WHY are we telling you?

Through work with the community and the WwTW Liaison Group in recent years, we remain committed to ensuring that you are advised of operational changes or odour risks.

# WHEN is this happening?

This notification relates to the 4<sup>th</sup> February to 7<sup>th</sup> February 2019, when the odour control unit at the sludge treatment centre will not be operational. Further updates will be issued as required.
