WHAT is happening?		
Kelda Water is planning to drain down, clean and maintain one of the two digesters. Work by our specialist contractors will commence on the 20th September. During this work there is a potential for an increase in odour risk from the site as it will be necessary for the digester to be partially open to the atmosphere for a limited period of time. An odour risk assessment has been undertaken by Kelda and shared with Regulators. This sets out the activity plans for use of temporary equipment and measures for minimising odour risks.		
WHY are we telling you?		
Through work with the community and through the WwTW Liaison Group in recent years, we remain		
committed to ensure that operational changes or odour risks are advised.		
WHEN is this happening?		
This notification relates to the 20 <sup>th</sup> September, 10am-1pm, when the digester will be partially opened to		
atmosphere. Further updates will be issued as required.
