WHAT is happening?		
Nigg WwTW site operators, Kelda, will be undertaking a short shutdown of the sludge treatment system to replace control instrumentation on 2 of 4 treatment vessels. This will require cooling of the vessels prior to works commencing during the morning of 16 th February. These treatment vessels are located within the main sludge treatment building and although the vessels will be partially opened for the maintenance work odour extraction and treatment will continue in line with the site Odour Management Plan.		
WHY are we telling you?		
As part of our ongoing commitment to minimise any inconvenience associated with the operation of the treatment works, we recognise the need to maintain open communication with our neighbours. An odour risk assessment has been undertaken for what is recognised as an odour sensitive task and although the wind direction is forecast to be from the west/south west (to the North Sea) we would like to assure you that Kelda are aware of the need for careful management of the maintenance works.
