WHAT is happening?

In accordance with the site Odour Management Plan, Seafield WwTW site operators, Veolia, will be undertaking essential planned maintenance, for the safety checks on High Voltage (HV) electrical system throughout the whole site.

WHY are we telling you?


As part of our ongoing commitment to minimise any inconvenience associated with the operation of the treatment works, we recognise the need to maintain open communication with our neighbours.

WHEN is this happening?

The HV maintenance programme will span a two week period with two complete site electrical shutdowns on the 16th and 17th October for three hours each day, scheduled to take place during daylight working hours. Temporary power generation will be on site to ensure that key water assets are available during these two short site shutdowns. With winds predicted to be offshore during these two short shutdown periods, the likelihood of significant odour emissions impacting upon the community is considered to be low risk. We shall inform stakeholders when this activity has been completed.
