



Taking care of the sewer network in Tay Street & Shore Road – Project Update.

We are continuing our upgrade works to the existing sewer in Tay Street and Shore Road to provide additional capacity to support the city's continuing growth, while also reducing the risk of sewer flooding affecting low-lying areas near the Tay between Muirton and the City Centre. Despite impacts of severe weather in recent weeks, work onsite has been progressing well.

Update: Tay Street

Works are currently progressing well in Tay Street, and we would like to thank the residents and businesses for their patience and co-operation whilst we continue this section of work. We expect the current phase of work in Tay Street to be complete before the end of November with the next phase of work scheduled to begin on Monday 8th January 2024 in order to minimise disruption over the festive period. This will mean there will be reduced activity onsite during the month of December but, we will ensure the site is kept safe and tidy. Please note there will be no change during this time to the road closure and "running lane".

The next phase of work will have a direct impact as the current "running lane" in place to assist access to businesses and residents in Tay Street will not be maintained in its current form.

During the next phase of work in Tay Street

- Closure of the running lane with restricted access to rear car parks for 76-78 and 90 Tay Street maintained via a one-way entrance/exit at the side of 90 Tay Street.

- Private car park to 72 Tay Street will be closed. We will liaise directly with residents whose access will be restricted during this time.

Shore Road Update:

Work is progressing well in Shore Road, and we would like to thank the businesses for their patience and co-operation whilst we continue this section of work. Work will continue to progress on Shore Road up until Friday 22nd December and will recommence on the 8th January 2024.

Shore Road Traffic Management

The 3-way traffic lights in place on Edinburgh Road at the junction with Friarton Road are being manually controlled between the hours of 15:30pm and 17:30pm Monday -Friday. In addition, Cromlix Road will be closed at the junction with Friarton Road during the hours of 15:30PM-17:30PM Monday to Friday to prevent commuters utilising this road as a short cut.

The alternative exit route for HGVs **only** is still in operation via the roadway at the southern edge of the Lesser South Inch.

Entry and Exit from the South Inch Car Park is from the top end of Shore Road via Marshall Place utilising the previous exit only.

Please note the car park is now Pay and Display as installed and operated by Perth and Kinross Council.

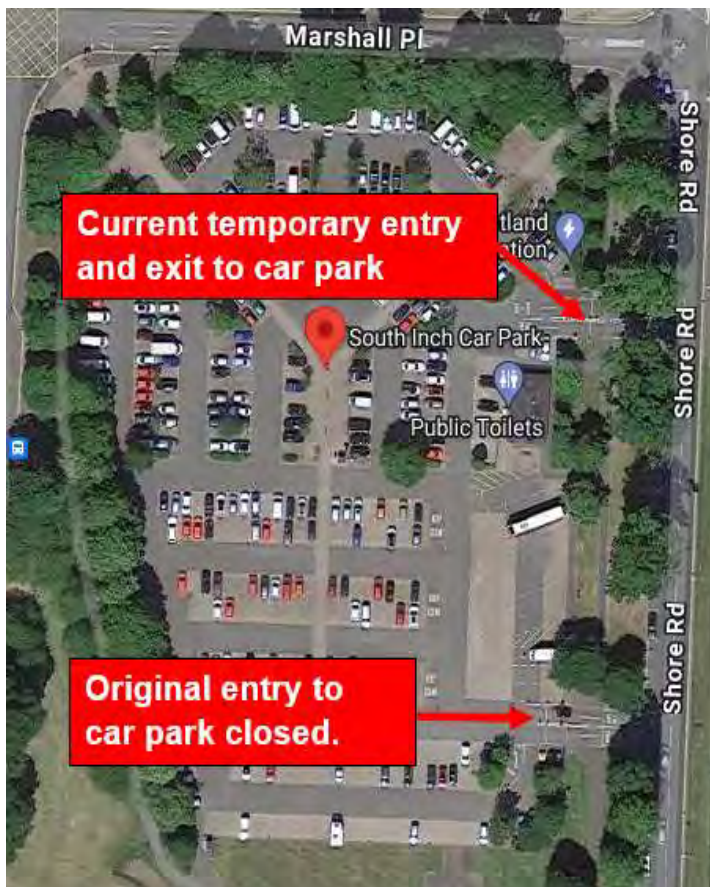


Image: South Inch Car Park

To oversee the significant programme of investment that Scottish Water is delivering in Tay Street, Shore Road and elsewhere in Perth, an informal liaison group has been established to enable regular dialogue between members of our project team, councillors, other community representatives and local businesses. The group is currently meeting on the second Tuesday of each month to review progress and discuss any emerging issues.

Festive Period: Please note the site will be closed for the Christmas period from the 22nd December to 8th January 2024.

Perth and Kinross Council have agreed to carry out extra winter road maintenance to ensure safety over the periods of colder weather in Friarton Road and the HGV only diversion route.
