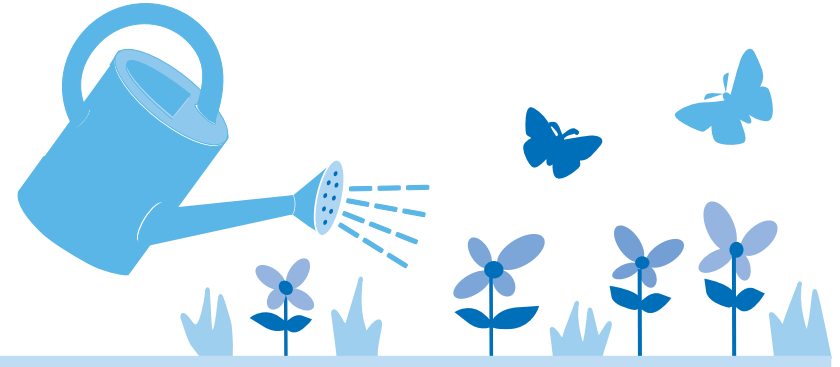


Top tips on how to use water wisely



Tip 1: make sure taps aren't dripping, turn them off properly or replace the washer.

Tip 2: use a watering can instead of a hosepipe in the garden.

Tip 3: boil the kettle with only the water you need.

Tip 4: use a bucket to wash the car instead of a hosepipe.

Tip 5: take a shower instead of a bath.

Tip 6: reduce the amount of water your home uses for toilet flushing by using a water-saving device in your toilet cistern.

Toilet flushing accounts for about 30% of the water used in your home. When you install a Save-a-Flush in your toilet cistern, you can save 1 litre of water every time you flush*.

As well as the tips above, when you're out and about report any water leaks you see to our Customer Helpline.

* If your toilet cistern has a volume of less than 6 litres or is a dual-flush model you should not use the Save-a-Flush in it as these are already water efficient.

** A maximum of 2 Save-a-Flush will be sent per household address.
